



## Sedona Swim New Swimmer Registration

Dear Parents and Swimmers,

We are excited that you would like to join the Sedona Swordfish Swim Team, and hope that your association with the sport of swimming will be life-long and enjoyable. Research shows that kids who learn the dedication, determination and competitive spirit that swimming requires apply these learned skills to everything they do. Success (in life) through swimming is inevitable.

Sedona Swim Team is a United States Swimming (USS) affiliated team coached by professionally certified Swim Coaches and directed by a parent elected and parent-run Board of Directors.

Registration paperwork must be complete and turned in with fees before your child can swim with us. Our team is run by dedicated parent volunteers. Please read everything thoroughly, fill out everything completely, get your swimmer to practice on time, mark your calendar to be sure you can help run our home meets, and help the team with the committee that you designated on your registration form.

The following information is intended to help you complete the registration process and forms.

### ***Fees:***

The session dues are provided in the documentation for each specific session located on the website. As a general rule the session dues are \$80 per swimmer per month and we offer a 25% discount for multiple swimmers.

### ***Pool Fees:***

In general these are \$20 per swimmer per month. When we swim in Sedona these fees can be included with the session dues in one check. When we swim at the Hilton, you will be responsible for paying the Hilton directly on the first of each month to obtain a facilities pass.

***\*Note: Meet fees are the responsibility of each family. You will be invoiced separately for these prior to each meet since these amounts vary for each competition.***

### ***US Swimming Registration:***

Since Sedona Swim Team is a US Swimming affiliated team, all swimmers must be a registered member of US Swimming and renew their membership annually. Please refer to the bottom of the registration page of the website for the application form, instructions and applicable fee. The fees are to be paid to the Sedona Swim Team and can be included with the session dues. ***First time registrants must provide proof of age by including a copy of their birth certificate.***



**Invoices:**

Deadline for payment will be the **first Friday of each session**. Our intention is that your swimmer(s) be able to participate fully in all practices and meets and therefore kindly request **all fees be paid in full by the deadlines unless communication and arrangements are made directly with the Swim Team Treasurer, Christy Seip.**

*Please do not give fees to coaches on deck.*

**Swim Team Forms:**

As the Sedona Swim Team continues to improve its organizational policies and procedures, we ask that you complete several new documents in preparation for this session. Instructions for each form are included on each form.

**Swimmer Registration Form:** It is essential that we have current and accurate contact information, especially email addresses and phone numbers so we can communicate with you in a timely manner.

**Parent Volunteer Form:** The sustainability of the Sedona Swim Team is directly related to the involvement of parents. Please share your talents to continue to strengthen and improve the team. We are asking one family member to become involved.

**Swimmer Code of Conduct:** The Sedona Swim team is committed to creating a positive, fun, and quality learning environment for all swimmers. Therefore, all swimmers need to understand and agree to support the expectations of coaches and respect their fellow swimmers.

**US Swimming Registration:** This is only required for swimmers who do not hold a current **annual** US Swimming Athlete Card. Please complete the **separate** US Swimming Registration Form posted on the website that is not included in this packet.

**We ask that every family complete the new forms once unless any of your information changes.** Once you have completed all forms, you will only need to complete the fee calculations form for each of the sessions in any given year. These are found in the session section of the website and are arranged by season and dates.

## Swimmers Code of Conduct

Sedona Swim Team has had a long tradition of producing top competitive swimmers while also offering recreationally interested swimmers the opportunity to develop their swimming ability. This tradition continues through the Vision and Values leadership of our coaches, the dedication of our swimmers and the support of our parents.

Any conduct which is detrimental to the good reputation and integrity of the Sedona Swim Team may be cause for temporary suspension or expulsion from the Team. Such conduct includes, but is not limited to:

Use of any illegal substance at any meet or any Sedona Swim Team practice or other function of Sedona Swim Team.

Destruction of property at any meet or Sedona Swim Team practice or other functions of the Sedona Swim Team. The Team is not responsible for lost or stolen articles.

Violation of any local, state or federal laws at any meet, Sedona Swim Team practice or other function of Sedona Swim Team.

Disrespect to, or abuse (verbal or physical) of any Sedona Swim Team staff member, Team member or Facility staff.

Examples of good conduct include: good sportsmanship, respectful communications, demonstrating positive team spirit, support and teamwork, volunteerism and encouraging your fellow teammates in the lanes and at swim meets.

Examples of misconduct include: stealing, messing with personal items in someone's locker, hurting, hitting, harassing or sniping at team mates, spitting pool water in team mates faces, tugging or tapping team mates underwater to irritate them, being mean in general or making mean comments to team mates, not being truthful, lying, using culturally sensitive slang or swearing, making inappropriate personal contact, using alcohol or tobacco or any drug, causing any distraction from the vision of swimming and the core values of the team.
